His first item of many during the day was to show the versatility of the round skew, Gary's signature gouge.





Next item was a humming top, in maple.







The hole in the top is square with a 45deg angle on each side to make it whistle



Next – Pendant using a purpose made jig.




Formed from a slice of any figured hardwood

Small hole in centre and mounted between centres



In jig, turn one side then the other side.






Next – a pepper mill in maple



Body drilled for grinder mechanism






Scratch board for marking the shape







Next – a round picture frame - mounted on screw chuck



Reversed onto large jaws and cut inset for photo, etc.



Reverse on jaws and shape the face of the frame



Next –one of Gary's classics – an idiot stick








Pat and Gary during pat's attempt

Small grindstone shaped to form groove on the plum





Next – a Banksia nut mushroom – using the waste portion of the nut





Finally – the Tippee Top







For the spinning top to work correctly the base must be given a slightly flattened shape
